1. Discuss the definition.
2. Historical Events: Before the out break of WW11, Winston Churchill tried to convince England that Germany was a great threat to all of Europe. The English government would not listen to Churchill and instead tried to broker a treaty with Hitler to procure peace. Hitler broke the treaty and WW11 began.
3. References in the Bible
 - a. Acts 18: 24-28 Apollos, though eloquent and educated, was willing to receive instruction from a simple married couple named Priscilla and Aquila. He had a teachable spirit.
4. Illustrated in the life of Jesus
 - a. John 5: 19-20
 - b. John 8: 28 Jesus did and spoke as His Father gave Him instruction.
5. Application: What are the areas in your life where you have the most trouble being teachable? It takes self confidence to be teachable. Could it take pride to remain unteachable?
